• 1/4/2021: Pre-K, Cluster and teachers/staff outside the classroom are to return for in person learning. Students in Pre-K and Cluster will return on 1/11/2021. 30

students are expected to return on 1/11/2021 and on 1/25 the remaining staff is scheduled to return. Students in grades K-8 who chose in-person learning will return as well-estimated at 125 kids. That is a total of 25% of the school population is choosing in person learning. *These numbers are subject to change as the landscape changes and more information is made available to all Stakeholders.* Classes will run M-F from 8-3 pm.

- Measures are in place for the return: PPE, Signage, Filters,
- Pre-K Setup: 1 teacher has been approved for ADA/Telework. Students will be split into 2 classrooms).
- 7th & 8th has about 15 students scheduled to return (8 will be in 1 class, and 7 in another class.
- Students will remain in their classrooms/desk all day. Washroom breaks will be scheduled, lunch will be in the classroom, and Special's teachers will travel to the classrooms to hold classes.
- So far we only have enough students for 1 pod.
- CPS is not providing a lot of feedback

Mrs. Carrasco has resigned. She is taking another job that involves coaching. New teacher will be the student teacher from Wheaton. She will be placed/assigned in January of 2021. In the meantime, 3 teachers have been helping out- Mrs Castillo, Mrs. Carabotta, Ms. Bunker.
