Principal's Report:

- **Expressions of Gratitude:** Teacher, Staff, Parent, Community, and Student Shout-Outs

Competency A- Champions teacher and staff excellence through a focus on continuous improvement in development to develop and achieve the vision of high expectations for all students

- **The Student Online Personal Protection Act (SOPPA)** is new legislation aimed at protecting student and teacher data from 3rd party Ed Tech solutions. The new SOPPA laws come into affect July 2021 and the district is working diligently to ensure that CPS is in compliance with the new standards and that student and teacher data are protected and safeguarded at the highest level.

- Personalized Learning: The final interview was on Wednesday to approve our Blueprint. This granted us an additional 100,000 to be spent by May 21st. Esperanza has been working tirelessly to ensure this happens.
- We have two summer design teams aligned to the CIWP: Literacy and Dual Language the objective of these teams is to redesign instruction to align vertically and horizontally.
- With money from PL we were able to purchase classroom furniture, technology (Chromebooks, Starboards), software, and a 7/8th grade math program.

Competency B- Creates powerful professional learning systems to guarantee learning for all students

- Professional Development is ongoing in both Personalized Learning and Dual Language. In addition, we are exploring Standards based grading practices. With the help of our PL coach Kevin Russel.
- Ms. Martinez and Ms. Lewandowski have been extremely busy completing ACCESS testing.

Competency C- Build a culture focused on college and career readiness

- Preschool enrollment for SY21: 68 spots have been offered. There are 40 spots in our ½ day program with 16 of these placements dedicated to diverse learners. There are 60 spots in our full day program with 8 spots dedicated to diverse learners.
- 44 8th grade students have received offers to select enrollment schools

Competency D- Empowers and motivates families and community to become engaged

- Covid testing for staff happens weekly. About ½ the staff is tested every week. The testing is optional

Competency E- Relentlessly pursues self-disciplined thinking and actions

- The staff has been working relentlessly to make sure students are receiving the best possible instruction during remote learning. Please support them as we make the transition to in person instruction. This is a difficult time with many unknowns, but we are working to anticipate and resolve issues that occur.
