If your child becomes sick at school they may be sent to the carerom to be evaluated by a nurse. If they have some of the following symptoms you may be asked to have your child evaluated by a medical provider before they return to school. I am also attaching a flowchart in the event someone tests positive for COVID.

- Fever (100.4 degrees Fahrenheit or higher)
 - Swollen Neck Glands
 - Persistent Cough (runny nose, eye drainage)
 - Difficulty Breathing (short of breath, tight chest)
 - Ear Pain or Discharge
 - Diarrhea (loose-frequent bowel movements)
 - Skin Rash
 - Sore Throat
 - Vomiting
 - Headache
 - Chills
 - Extreme Pallor
 - Dizziness and Weakness
 - Severe Pain/Body Aches
 - Other (please specify):
